FREE GRANT WRITING WORKSHOP TO BE HELD

St. Andrew's Health Center will host a free grant-writing workshop Thursday, October 29 from 8:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. at the Tech Center, 519 Main Street in Bottineau.

“The Grant Writing Process” workshop will provide participants from organizations such as schools, faith-based organizations, non-profit agencies, community service groups and businesses, with the tools necessary to compete successfully for grant funds. It will cover methods for searching and applying for private and public grant funding, the critical steps for planning and writing a grant proposal and the most common components for most grant applications.
